




## **Jerusalem**



Municipal Boundaries of Jerusalem, 1947-2000

- Archeological findings point to settlement upon and around the site of Jerusalem's Old City dating from about 4000 BCE.
- From 1923 to 1947, Jerusalem was the administrative capital of Mandate Palestine, the League of Nations Mandate under British control.
- From 1949-1967, western Jerusalem was under the control of newly-founded Israel while eastern Jerusalem was controlled by Jordan.
- In 1967, eastern Jerusalem was seized by Israel.
- Under Israeli control, Jerusalem's municipal boundaries were expanded, and policies displacing Arabs from western Jerusalem and the Old City and creating Jewish settlements in eastern Jerusalem were instituted.
